We are excited to offer an Australian first at our on property sale this year, with an unprecedented number of DNA tested Homozygous Polled Charolais Bulls on offer. We and other studs have offered a couple of these Homozygous polled bulls in past sales but this is the first sale to offer a quantity. While they are tested positive for this polled gene we haven't lost sight of the need to retain other important MSA traits such as calving ease, carcass, yield, growth, muscle, positive fat and eating quality.

ANGUS LINE UP

The Angus line up this year we are proud of and is the best line we have presented. They are real industry focused commercial bulls, with more muscle and bone but still retaining softness & positive fat. Most bulls are AI & ET sons from some of the best commercially focused bulls in the industry including Te Mania Emperor, Berkley, Ardrossan Equator, GAR Predestined, Carabar Docklands, Rennylea Edmund E11, SAV Net Income and some really impressive natural calves from our new stud sires, Irelands Gapsted and Millah Murrah Highlander. We also have a line of bulls from females we purchased from the record breaking and renowned Millah Murrah Angus Stud. These bulls are standouts.

YEARLING BULL PROGRAM

As per previous sales we will be offering a number of working age yearling bulls. We have had good feedback from previous buyers that have had great success with the yearling bulls. The purchase of yearling bulls can allow:

- Potentially lower initial purchase price for the latest genetics.
- Better adaptability to harsher conditions when they are lighter and more active.

- Potentially an extra year of use at start of breeding life and an extra year at end of breeding life.

- Less injuries from fighting with other bulls.

We do adopt a holistic breeding approach to both our Charolais and Angus herds and don't just concentrate on the poll trait alone. We use science and commonsense. The genetics on offer are designed to make the beef industry more sustainable with a MSA targeted approach:

- Polled cattle to reduce stress of dehorning on the cattle and handlers and help pacify animal liberationists. (also reducing costs in labour and reducing losses through bruising).
- Focus on grass fed traits so cattle can finish early on either grass or in feedlot.
- Quiet temperament reducing stress on handlers and animals and reducing dark cutters in processing.
- Calving ease.
- Rigorous data collection and high ranking on Breedplan for both breeds to make bull selection easier.
- All bulls are fully guaranteed, Vet and semen checked; vaccinated for Tick fever, Vibrio, Pestivirus, 7 in 1 and 3 day sickness.

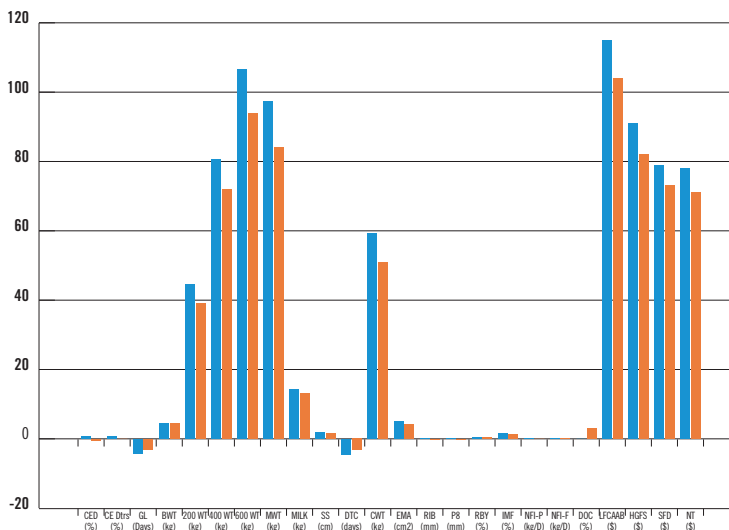

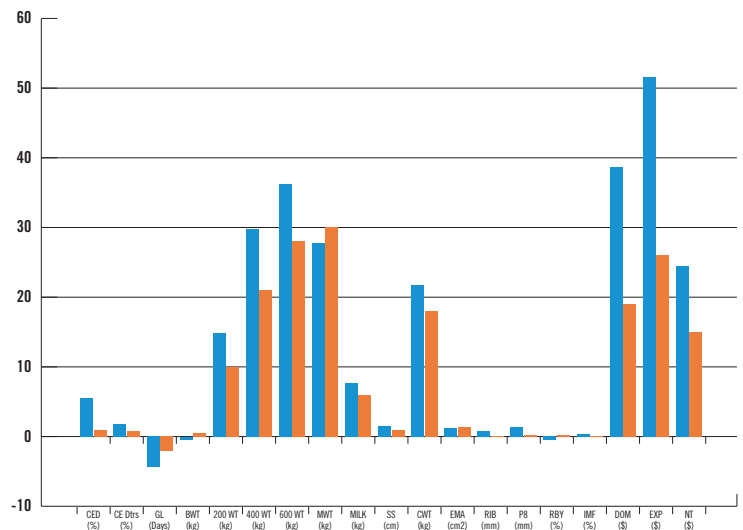

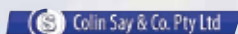

SALE INFORMATION



SALE DATE AND PRIOR INSPECTION TIME:

Selling will commence at 1.00pm on Friday 17th October, 2014.

Bulls may be inspected from 10.00 a.m. on the morning of the sale, or at any other time by arrangement with the agents or vendors.

SELLING SYSTEM:

Sale of animals will be conducted under normal auction conditions. Please check with the Selling Agents to obtain a buyer's number if you are considering making a purchase. Successful Purchasers are requested to give written advice to the Selling Agents, regarding transport arrangements, at the conclusion of the sale.

REBATE:

4% Rebate to outside agents registering Bull buyers, in writing, PRIOR to the sale, and settling on their behalf within 14 days of the date of invoice.

PHONE BIDDING:

We have full mobile phone coverage at the sale. If you intend purchasing over the phone, please contact the selling agents to reserve a line.

GST:

All animals are sold **exclusive** of GST.

INSURANCE:

Bulls are like any other piece of valuable farm equipment and it is wise to insure them, especially for their first six months of working life. There are a number of options available through Landmark Insurance at the sale venue.

AUCTION PLUS

Auction Plus will be operating at the Sale. Please register 24hrs before the sale.

REGISTRATION:

Ownership transfer of bulls will be registered by the vendors with Angus Australia or Charolais Australia provided accurate transferee details are supplied with the Buyers Instruction form.

CATERING:

Please join us for complimentary lunch and after sale drinks.

PHYSICAL EXAMINATION OF BULLS

All bulls offered for sale will be vet checked near sale date and only sold if deemed satisfactory for the following inspections:

- Palpation of internal genitalia
- Palpation of Scrotal Contents
- Semen Testing

TEMPERAMENT

The bulls have been handled with horses, ATV utilities and on foot. We know their temperament individually and are confident that under normal circumstances each animal in the sale is of sound temperament. Understandably each year on sale day an occasional bull misbehaves due to the big change to the yard area and the pressures of strange people invading their space.

HEALTH QA:

The bulls are ready for immediate use. We have treated them as follows:

- Double vaccinated them with Vibrovax
- Vaccinated for Tick Fever
- Double Vaccinated them with 7 in 1
- Double Vaccinated for 3 Day
- Drench with Cydectin Pour On prior to sale





BULL HANDLING

On arrival at their new home it is important a suitable mob of animals is yarded to greet the bull and minimize the stress on the bull. Suitable animals include pregnant cows, steers, certainly not other bulls.

The bulls are in good joining condition at point of sale, but it is imperative to ensure good nutrition for the bull during the joining period. You should check the bulls regularly to see they are working, especially in the early stages of joining when the majority of problems occur and early intervention can minimize the damage to the bull and to conception rates.

When joining is complete, bulls should be drenched and placed on good pasture to get back into first grade health without being allowed to get over-fat.

WARRANTY

THE VENDOR WARRANTS THAT:

1. Bulls are fertile and capable of natural service within 6 months of date of sale to the purchaser ("Warranty Period"); and

THE VENDOR WILL EITHER:

1. Provide a satisfactory replacement or
2. Provide a credit for use at the next Ascot Cattle Co Bull Sale equal to the purchase price (excluding any costs and expenses of the purchaser in taking delivery) minus salvage value:

WHERE:

1. the purchaser claims a bull is infertile, upon purchaser submitting a veterinary report after the expiration of the Warranty Period stating that the bull is infertile or incapable of natural service, and a Statutory Declaration by the purchaser to the effect that the

substance of the report is true and correct The veterinarian must state that in his/her opinion there is no evidence that the bull has suffered any injury or illness during the Warranty Period which could have affected his breeding ability. The veterinary report and Statutory Declaration must be forwarded to the seller within 14 days of the Warranty Period expiring.

THE PURCHASER ACKNOWLEDGES THAT:

The purchaser does not rely and it is unreasonable for the purchaser to rely on the skill or judgment of the seller as to whether the bulls supplied are reasonably fit for any purpose for which they are being acquired.

To the extent permitted by law all other conditions and warranties implied by law in respect of the state, quality and condition of the bulls which may apart from this clause be binding on the Seller are excluded.

The Seller has no liability (including liability in negligence) to any person for any loss or damage consequential or otherwise suffered or incurred by that person arising from the sale of the bulls to the purchaser.

HEALTH & SAFETY OF VISITORS TO OUR SALE (RULES & ADVICE)

All the sale bulls have been screened for temperament and are quiet to handle under normal circumstances. However there are inherent risk associated with cattle handling.

VISITORS ENTER THE CATTLE PENS AT THEIR OWN RISK. CHILDREN MUST NOT ENTER THE YARDS.

People entering the yards are at risk of injury. Be especially alert of bulls fighting and if one is playful with you, do not respond by patting his head.

What a bull considers a playful nudge can break human legs! We do not expect the bulls to be aggressive with humans, but sale day places extraordinary pressure on them as they experience an entirely foreign environment. Remember the quietest bull is in fact an unpredictable animal.

Do not crowd the bulls or loiter inside the pens. We cannot cover every example of the dangers of cattle handling, so please use common sense and be alert at all times. Don't enter the pens unnecessarily.

Please call upon any of the agents for an escort through the bulls if required. The days of bravado with stock have passed under current OH&S legislation.

WORKING AGE YEARLINGS BECOMING POPULAR



In Australia and other parts of the world, there is a trend towards using bulls at yearling age (12-18 months). This allows introduction of superior genetic material into herds a year earlier than normal, resulting in faster genetic improvement.

Their introduction has the potential to allow breeders to extend the working lives of bulls by a year or more, lowering the bulls costs of a herd. This extra workload is achieved at the time in their lives when they are young, lean, fit and exuberant. They are free of the structural problems that beset older bulls.

Yearling bulls have much to offer, both genetically and financially. However, poor management can reduce calving percentages, compromise animal welfare and limit their lifetime potential. In order to harness the immense potential of yearling bulls, special management is required-their age and physiological status demands it.

WHY ARE YEARLINGS DIFFERENT?

Apart from their age, yearling bulls are different from older bulls in a number of ways.

They are still growing strongly, and tend to be leaner, carrying less body fat reserves. They are usually fitter and more agile, although not necessarily stronger, than older bulls. They are also smaller in size and more subordinate to older bulls which makes them more injury-prone when mixed with them, especially in the sexually competitive environment of a joining group.

Yearling bulls are usually sexually inexperienced, are more likely to be sexually immature, and their health and body condition are far more sensitive to poor nutrition and the challenges of internal and external parasites.

Although special management is required, much of it is common sense.

WHY USE YEARLINGS?

Cattle producers with experience in managing yearlings often say that they prefer them because they settle in better, mix with other cattle more easily and are easier to handle than older bulls. However, there are some far more tangible incentives in using them.

In south-eastern Australia, the average working life of a bull is less than 3 years – not a very satisfactory performance for one of the main operational costs of a beef cattle enterprise. By first using bulls as yearlings, the working life of a bull can be extended by a year or more – a 25% increase. As a result, the purchase price and running costs of bulls can be spread over more calves. This reduces bull costs per calf and boosts profitability.

Yearling bulls also allow cattle breeders the opportunity to achieve faster rates of genetic improvement. This is due to the influence of what geneticists call 'generation interval', that is, the average age of parents when their calves are born. By using genetically superior bulls as young as possible, faster turnover rates of genes are achieved. Joining yearling bulls to yearling heifers can maximise genetic improvement by lowering generation intervals.

Yearling bulls are significantly less costly to produce. Seedstock suppliers sell their bulls 6-12 months earlier, which simplifies their management and reduces overheads.

In addition to these advantages, there is strong circumstantial evidence to suggest that bulls used first as yearlings have even longer working lives because of superior fitness and lower levels of body fat. The more active lives of these bulls means that they are maintained at body weights below their genetic potential. As a result, less stress is placed on their skeletal structure when serving, with less likelihood of breakdowns occurring.

The two biggest causes of breakdowns in bulls are hip arthritis (over 50% of all wastage) and broken penis. Over-conditioning bulls for shows and sales, especially multivendor sales, exacerbates both these conditions. It would appear that bulls used first as yearlings are less affected by these serious sources of economic loss.

WILL YEARLING BULLS BE SEXUALLY MATURE?

Yearling bulls will generally be sexually mature if they:

- are well grown
- are in good condition (fat score of high 2 or low 3)
- are 12 months of age or older
- have a scrotal circumference of 32cm or more at
- 12-14 months. The onset of puberty is directly related to the level of nutrition.

Bulls on a high plane of nutrition are more likely to reach puberty at a younger age.



In some cases, this may be as young as 8 months of age. Poorly grown or low-condition bulls are risky for use as yearlings, as they may not have reached puberty.

Around puberty, testicles grow very quickly, resulting in a rapid increase in scrotal circumference. In well-grown breeds this 'growth spurt' is normally expected to take place between 8 and 13 months of age, under optimal nutrition.

SERVING ABILITY

Yearling bulls are usually sexually inexperienced. As a result, they are sometimes, but not always, a little clumsy and awkward. However, young bulls have very steep learning curves. This learning phase may cause minor delays in the start of calving. Should this be a problem, joining should start 7 or 14 days earlier than normal to compensate for the slight delay.

MATING MANAGEMENT

Yearling bulls can be effectively joined either individually or in peer groups. They should not be joined in a group with older bulls because of 'dominance'. In a mixed group, older bulls may get up to 75% of the cows in calf while young, subordinate bulls miss out. Joining yearlings with older bulls is not only wasteful and inefficient, it is also risky, as the young bulls tend to be more injury-prone. In addition, there is less risk of exposure to venereal diseases when young bulls are joined in peer groups.

SINGLE OR MULTIPLE JOINING?

Bulls that are being watched by other bulls are likely to serve females more often—they respond to an audience. Conception rates in multiple-joining groups are usually higher, which is understandable, since there are more services made in multiple-joining groups than in single-joining groups. It is not uncommon for bulls joined in groups to fight in the first week of joining, even though they had been run together before joining. Apparently they sometimes need to re-establish a pecking order. This settling-down phase may help explain why calves occasionally start arriving later than they should.

Multiple-joining groups have traditionally been a kind of on-farm insurance policy against the risk of having a dud—if one bull in the group is freeloading, the others will cover for him, and so conception rates don't suffer. But the insurance does not come free (it never does).

There is evidence that injury rates in multiple-joining groups are higher, especially when the bulls in the group are of different ages.

The incidence of 'broken penis' is higher in multiple groups, especially when young bulls are joined in a group with older bulls. Yearling bulls should never be joined with older bulls—the risk of injury is just too great. They should be joined either by themselves or with other yearlings.

WON'T YEARLINGS BE TOO SMALL TO REACH MY COWS?

If the biggest cows in a joining group fail to conceive, size may be a factor. However, it is risky making 'blanket' statements. The sexual prowess of some small, high-serving, yearling bulls serving dry cows significantly larger than themselves has been witnessed at Trangie Agricultural Research Station, and one wonders how it was physically possible. Sex is apparently a wonderful motivator!

WON'T JOINING BULLS AS YEARLINGS KNOCK THEM AROUND?

Bulls do not die from too much sex. However, they do lose condition. This will depend on their health, the quality of their feed, the length of the joining period and the number of females they are joined with. A lot of common sense is needed in order to strike a balance. In extensive areas with only average or poor quality feed, the joining season should be restricted to 6-8 weeks.

The use of yearling bulls is limited only by their health and fitness. It does not matter whether they 'won't grow out' as it's just not relevant. If our beef industry is to make progress, we must purge our minds of the belief that a bull has to be fat and well grown to be any good. The value of a bull should be measured by the performance of his offspring—not on what he looks like. After all, when was the last time you saw a fat rabbit, fox or roo? Those species carry no subcutaneous fat, yet they don't appear to be facing extinction!

Maintaining bulls in anything fatter than 2 or 3 score condition is wasteful, counterproductive and inefficient. Bulls that are allowed to get fatter than this are either sexually inactive or under-used.

WON'T YEARLING BULLS HAVE SMALLER CALVES?

It is surprising how many cattle producers think that young bulls are more likely to sire small calves. They are purchased in the mistaken belief that they can reduce calving difficulties. Clearly that is not the case. There is no relationship between the age of a bull at joining and the weights of his calves.

MATING POTENTIAL

A more conservative approach is needed in the first year, until you have a track record for the performances of yearling bulls on your farm. In these situations, mating loads of only 25-30 females are recommended.

The condition of the yearling bulls is critical. If they drop below 2 score condition, sperm production may be impaired.

SUMMARY

In order to harness the potential of yearling bulls there are three crucial management requirements:

1. Join them either alone or with bulls of the same age.
2. Join yearling bulls for 6-8 weeks (2 cycles) only, then spell them for at least 3 months.
3. After removing yearling bulls from their joining groups, place them on high quality feed in specially prepared paddocks.

Experience has shown that many young bulls have been ruined because they have been joined for too long and under conditions that have challenged their survival. If, at any stage, yearling bulls drop below 2 score condition, they should be withdrawn from their joining group immediately.

WHY POLLED?



THE ASCOT CHAROLAIS POLLED FOCUS

Ascot is devoted to breeding Charolais cattle that are polled but still retain the correct phenotype, carcass qualities and fertility. Polled cattle have sometimes been criticized for losing bone, phenotype and carcass quality and perhaps rightfully so as in the past some breeders may have just bred the polled gene and disregarded the other important traits.

At Ascot we are endeavoring to have the best of both worlds. Great polled cattle.

Over the last couple of years we have made some real headway in this and through testing many of our cattle for the HOMOZYGOUS polled gene at the University of Qld we have found some lines or combinations that produce this gene more readily.

For those of you who are not familiar with the term Homozygous polled it means in summary animals that test with a very high percentage of this gene (say 90% and above) have a very high probability of throwing nearly all calves that are polled or perhaps scurred. This is even if the

other parent is horned. The gene once the animal has it is that strong that it can override the other parent.

At present we are using 5 homozygous polled stud sires in our herds at Warwick and Glen Innes. These are walking sires. We also use AI sires from Australia and overseas that have this gene. This year we tested a group of 50 2 year old heifers and of that 35 came back has homozygous polled. A result that enables us to mix and match our sires with these heifers so we can maintain the great Charolais carcass and fertility qualities.

This year we will have 5 homozygous (90%) polled bulls in the sale. This is great opportunity for both commercial breeders and stud breeders.

We as a stud thought over whether we should hold on to this perceived advantage and keep these bulls or just sell to them to commercial producers only but we are a great believers in improving the Charolais breed and improving the cattle industry in general so we have decided to release some of these bulls to whomever wants to take advantage of it and

introduce this advantage to their stud herds as well. An example would be if a charbray breeder wanted to breed a line of all polled charbrays they could use one of these homozygous tested bulls.

PHENOTYPE

Whilst we use the very latest of breeding technologies, phenotype is a major part of our breeding program. Our bulls will be quiet, polled, have great skin type and exhibit, weight, softness and easy doing ability.

CARCASE FOCUSED

We use ultra sound scanning for EMA, IMF% and fat cover. Combined with weight for age data, this gives us strong information on what our cattle can do. This data is submitted to Breedplan and is also available to clients whilst assessing.

GROWTH FOCUS

Weight is money. With that said we are focused on cattle that can grow quickly to MSA standards. The added benefit of this is moderate mature cow weight thus maintaining productive and efficient replacement females.

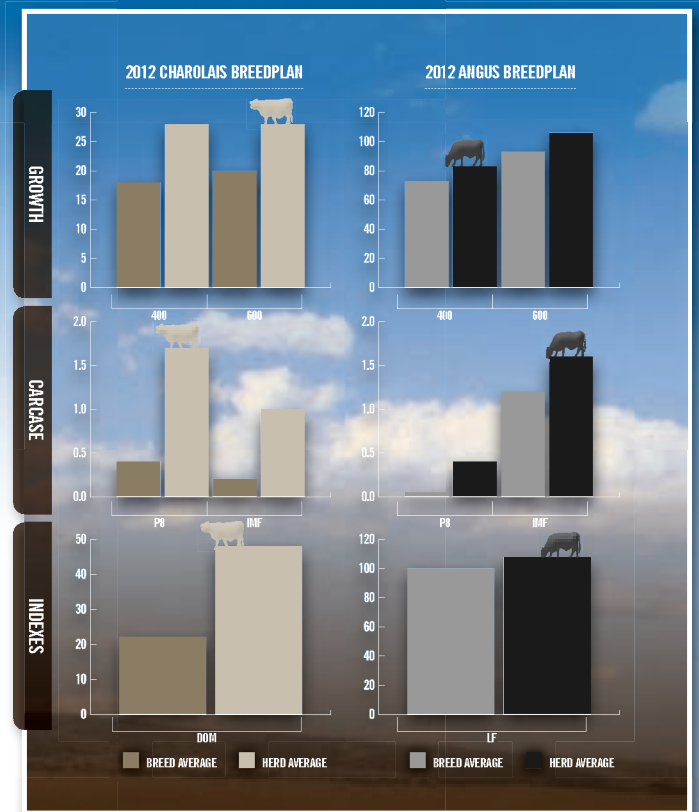

Every bull sold has been vaccinated for Pesti Virus, 7 in 1, 3 Day, Tick Fever, and Vibrio.

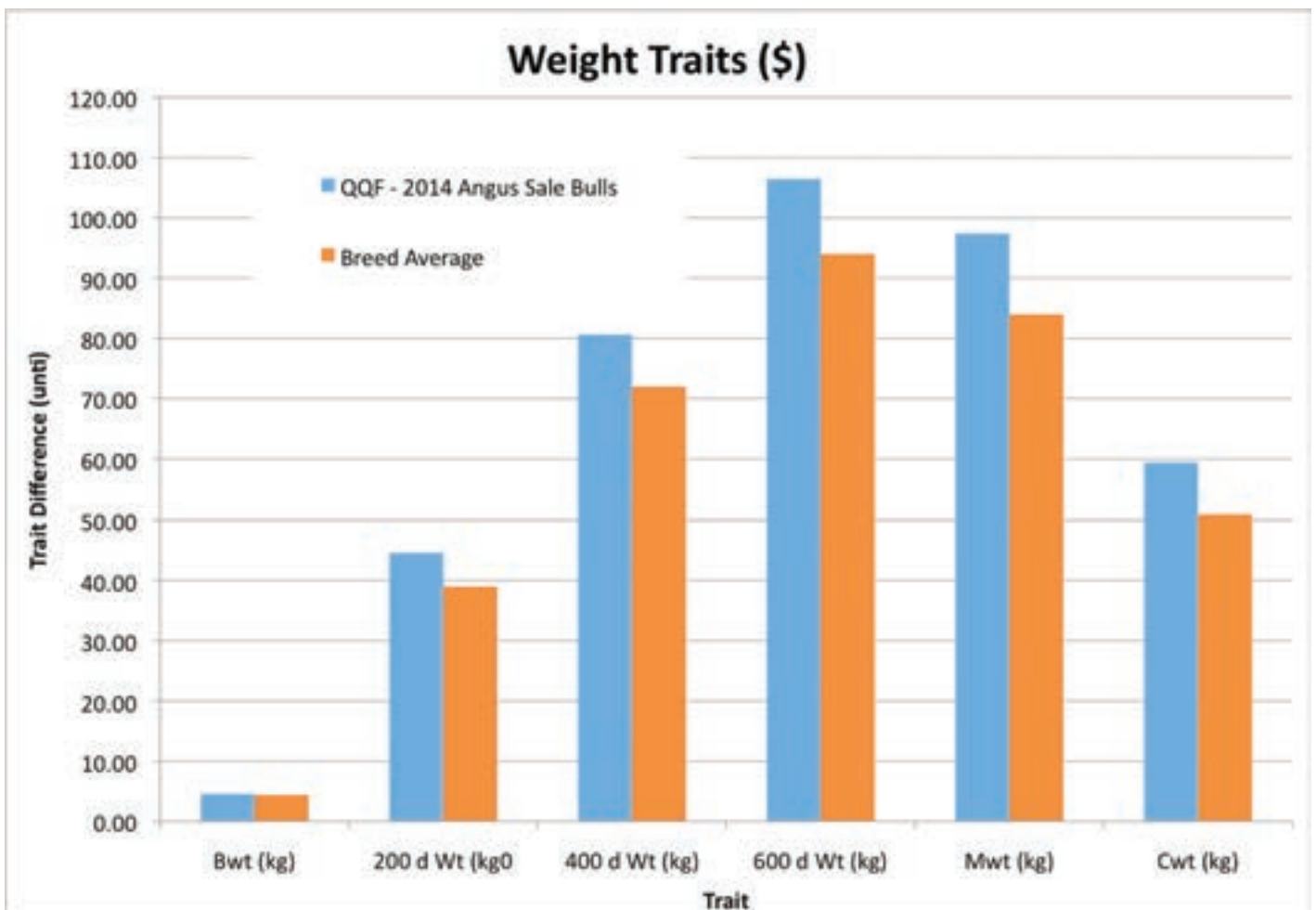
